

Win a Hot Lap at Clipsal 2010 with Orrcon Steel Comp –Terms & Conditions 2009

Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions of entry. Entry into the promotion deems acceptance of these conditions of entry.

1. Entry is open to all South Australian Orrcon Steel customer contacts identified as Inactive accounts and/or Prospective accounts. Employees and contractors of the Promoter, its related companies, their agencies or members of their immediate families are ineligible. "Immediate family" means spouse, parent, natural or adopted child, siblings (whether natural or adopted by a parent), whether or not they live in the same household as the employee or contractor.
2. The promotion commences **1st October 2009** and closes on all orders invoiced by **31st January 2010**. The competition will be held at Orrcon, 121 Evans Rd Salisbury Q 4107.
3. To be eligible, entrants must register their interest via phone, online or post, open or reactivate an account with Orrcon Steel and purchase a minimum of AUD \$1500 (plus GST) during the competition period **1st October 2009 to 31st January 2010**. Inactive Orrcon accounts are also eligible to enter. Inactive accounts are accounts that have been opened with Orrcon, however no purchases have been made in the 60 days prior to the 19th June 2009. These accounts also are required to purchase a minimum of AUD \$1500 (plus GST) during the competition period. If required, inactive accounts may need to reapply for credit terms. All requests for credit are subject to Orrcon's standard credit approval process.

Any additional expenses incurred by the winner and guest in relation to goods and services that are not expressly specified as part of the prize (above) will be payable by the winner and any terms and conditions of the provider of the goods or services will apply.
